

The Yearbook of the "Gheorghe Șincai" Institute for Social Sciences and the Humanities of the Romanian Academy is a peer reviewed yearly academic publication.

Editors: the editors of the *Yearbook* decide upon the articles to be published. In the evaluation process the editors will take into account only the intellectual/ research content of the manuscripts. The race, gender, sexual orientation, religious beliefs, ethnicity, citizenship or political view of the authors should not influence the editors in the process of selection. The editors will reject from publication any material with potentially slanderous content, publication suspected of plagiarism or those that do not meet the copyright legal preventions. The manuscripts received are confidential until their publication. If the editors decide against publication they cannot use the manuscript in any other purposes without the expressed written permission of the author.

Peer reviewers: The peer reviewers support the editors of the Yearbook in deciding whether to publish a manuscript. They can contribute with suggestions to the authors to improve the materials that were submitted for publishing. In order to do that the peer reviewers will objectively evaluate the submitted manuscripts and will make clear their point of view on their academic quality. The materials that the peer reviewers receive are confidential and they have to treat them as such. Communication regarding the articles is restricted to the dialogue between the peer reviewer and editor.

Authors: The authors submitting manuscripts for publishing have to use the publishing regulations of the journal. They have to make sure that their manuscripts are original and the literature used is being correctly quoted. Any suspicion of plagiarism will be immediately followed by the rejection of the manuscript. The journal does not accept for publication manuscripts that are considered for publication elsewhere, or materials already published in other journals and volumes. Attempting to publish such an article is considered unethical. The author has to signal any mistakes in the text to the editors and cooperate with the editor to correct it. Issues related to copyrighted materials in the body of the manuscript have to be solved by the author prior to submitting the manuscript.
